

Program Overview

Drug and alcohol abuse can cost an individual their job, their family, and their life. At Wesley Family Services, we view chemical dependency as a chronic, progressive, and ultimately fatal disease that requires a lifelong pursuit of, and commitment to, recovery. Additionally, we recognize that a co-occurring condition has become the expectation in drug and alcohol treatment and that both disorders must be addressed concurrently in an integrated and supportive environment to maximize chances of treatment success.

Our Outpatient Drug and Alcohol program is committed to the treatment and rehabilitation of individuals enrolled in the program. The primary goals for each individual are:

- to obtain sobriety
- stabilization from mental illness
- develop the skills necessary to maintain a selfdirected, dual recovery program from both addiction and mental illness.

In order to do so, we provide an array of personalized outpatient and intensive outpatient services for individuals, family members, and loved ones.

Who the Drug & Alcohol Program Serves

- Individuals living in Armstrong, Washington, and surrounding counties.
- Individuals who are 13 years or older (Intensive Outpatient for individuals 18 years or older).
- Individuals experiencing a problem with drugs or alcohol that present no risk for severe withdrawal.
- Individuals experiencing a co-occurring mental health condition who are assessed as being psychiatrically stable.
- Individuals who demonstrate a willingness to participate with prescribed treatment, including abstinence, until determined to be a treatment goal.
- Individuals who are pregnant and using intravenous substances, pregnant and using substances, or using substances intravenously are given priority for admission.
