### **Community Integration**

Community Integration program of Wesley Family Services is designed to assist persons with disabilities in developing and enhancing vocational and social strengths while facilitating individual choice.

We are committed to providing quality services to persons with disabilities by identifying vocational interests while assisting people in optimizing selfsufficiency and community connections.

Our Community Integration program serves individuals in:

- Allegheny
- Armstrong
- Butler
- Westmoreland and surrounding areas

#### Services provided include:

- Pre-employment Transition Services
- Small Group Employment
- Supported Employment
- Customized Employment / Discovery

#### **Pre-Employment Transition**

Pre-Employment Transition Services is an Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR) sponsored service for students with disabilities. The services provided are interactive and utilize a curriculum to assist students in identifying career interests, enhancing work skills and exploring post-secondary opportunities needed for a seamless entry into community-integrated employment. The curriculum is tailored to each individual based on his/her learning needs and what each person brings to the learning experience. It is anticipated that students will build an awareness of personal attributes needed to gain confidence in order to take a leadership role in creating a successful future.

The curriculum is broken down between the following areas:

- Independent Living Skills
- Self-Advocacy Training
- Workplace Readiness
- Job Exploration

Other available services offered include:

- Group Shadowing
- Individual Job Shadowing

#### **Small Group Employment**

Small Group Employment is designed to support and enhance work skills of individuals who have a defined goal of competitive integrated employment. The service is provided at various business sites within the community. Service options include:

- Mobile Work Force/Enclave: Teams of individuals under supervision perform specific contractual duties with local business in lawn care, janitorial and floor maintenance.
- Work Station in Industry: Individual or group training at an industry site that is phased out once the individual demonstrates job knowledge and meets employer's expectations.
- Affirmative Industry: Operates as an integrated business, where people work together to carry out work functions of the business.

#### **Supported Employment**

This service supports individuals in developing work skills and adaptations needed to maximize the independence necessary to maintain employment in a competitive setting. Activities include three components:

- Career Assessment
- Job Finding and Development
- Job Coaching and Support

## **Customized Employment / Discovery**

This service is a flexible process based on discovering an individual's personal attributes, skills, tasks performed and work conditions needed in order to establish a vocation theme geared for competitive integrated employment. This is an enhanced version of Supported Employment that includes discovery, job finding/development and intensive job coaching and support needed for securing and maintaining competitive, integrated employment.

Customized Employment involves informational interviewing, job carving, job sharing and/or the negotiating of unmet work needs that can be filled by the job seeker. There is potential for entrepreneurship and self- sustained business opportunities through this program.
