Program Overview

The Child & Adolescent Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP) is a time-limited, intensive psychiatric treatment program for the treatment of children and adolescents 5 -18 years of age. The Child & Adolescent PHP provides stabilization of symptoms of children with emotional disturbances, supported diversion from inpatient care, and restoration to a level of functioning that enables a child to return to the community and appropriate educational placement.

The Child & Adolescent PHP offers a unique alternative to children in need of intensive treatment to address social, emotional and behavioral needs. The goal of the Child & Adolescent PHP is to identify problems that are preventing a child from functioning successfully in school, address these problems, and assist the child in transitioning back into the school environment.

Admission into the program is indicated by:

- The child demonstrates acute psychiatric symptoms which, if left untreated, may lead to inpatient care or other out-of-home placement.
- Failure to make progress in less restrictive mental health services.
- Difficulty functioning in various areas of the child's life.

Our Treatment Philosophy

The Child & Adolescent PHP is driven by Wesley Family Services' belief in respecting the rights, dignity and diversity of every individual. We believe in the capacity of each individual to achieve their greatest level of functioning. This is achieved through a partnership involving:

- The Individual
- The Individual's family
- Social and community resources,
- And by the promotion of personal growth by utilizing a strengths based approach

Treatment Modalities

The program is designed to provide mental health treatment through the following modalities:

- Individual Therapy
- Family Therapy
- Group Therapy

Discharge Planning

Multi-disciplinary discharge planning begins during the initial assessment, developing a plan for the child's continued success.

Education

The program offers a unique opportunity for children to receive education in a small therapeutic environment, staffed with a Certified Special Education Teacher and Behavioral Specialist.

Referrals

Referral to the program can be made by a parent/guardian, school official, hospital, mental health provider, or in the case of adolescents, the child themselves. Approval of a child's home school district must be obtained in order to be enrolled.
