

Families Outside: Helping Maintain the Family Unit

When parents go to prison, children and families hurt. Families can split permanently and children of incarcerated parents are six times more likely to be imprisoned later in their lives than children who do not have a parent incarcerated.

How do we help them deal with the pain, embarrassment and stigma that comes from having a family member or loved one in prison? How do we break this cycle of crime?

Families Outside, a service of Wesley Family Services, is one answer. Families Outside provides a unique service to families of incarcerated men and women. We provide transportation services to Pennsylvania's State Correctional Institutions and help children and adults develop the coping skills necessary to deal with the pain of having a loved one in the correctional system.

It is our belief that family members, especially children, need continued contact with their parents, even during incarceration.

Transportation Service

In order to help maintain the link between families and their incarcerated loved ones. Families Outside provides low cost transportation services to and from most State Correctional Institutions (SCI) throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. With the help of state and private funding, Families Outside is able to provide highly affordable fares to these families.
