In-Home Family Services

Our In-Home Family Services program is an intensive family-oriented service. We utilize structural strategic interventions designed to provide family preservation and reunification. To be eligible for this service, families must be referred by the designated Child Protective Services or Juvenile Probation Department in Allegheny or Westmoreland County. Treatment is focused on empowering the family to use their existing strengths, skills, and natural supports and resources to make positive, long-lasting changes that will develop self-reliance and improve the quality of life.

Services are delivered by a Wesley Family Services staff member with a Bachelor's or Master's degree in a social services-related field. Sessions occur two to three times a week, and can be provided in the home, Wesley Family Services office, or community setting. Services are provided at times that meet the needs and schedule of the family, including weekends and evenings. Staff is also available for 24/7 crisis support and intervention in order to stabilize the family. Staff works in collaboration with the family, natural supports, referring entities, and other involved service providers to set goals, provide services, monitor progress, and plan for discharge. Families are asked to take an active role in treatment, assessment, planning and implementation.

Services Offered

The following services are offered through the In-Home Family Services program:

- Assessment for safety
- Assessment for Mental Health needs
- Individual therapy (includes addressing conflict, relationship issues, truancy, incorrigibility)
- Family Therapy (includes addressing conflict, relationship issues, truancy, incorrigibility)
- Couples Therapy - Westmoreland County
- Supervised Visitation for reunification of children/youth with their parents and/or other appropriate family member, which includes documented observation of parenting skills and communication techniques
- Court testimony
- Parenting education (including but not limited to hands-on parenting instruction, parenting curriculum, discipline, boundaries/structure, child development)
- Anger management
- Stress management
- Life skills, decision making, budgeting, home maintenance and managing a household
- Facts of Life Curriculum (individual and group) - Westmoreland County
- Aggression Replacement Training Group
- Assistance to linkage with community resources (housing, Department of Human Services mental health/substance abuse services, Food Bank, health care, child care, schools, domestic violence support)
- Case collaboration/coordination with other providers working with child/youth and family
- Transportation to court appointments and other required services - Westmoreland County
- 24/7 Crisis Support
