In-Home Services

In Home Services provides short term programming and support for children, adolescents and families who are actively involved in and referred by the juvenile justice system. These services work in collaboration with children, adolescents, and families to set goals that will address risk factors such as unsafe and/or unstable family setting, adverse family interactions, disengagement from school, community and/or work, behavioral health issues, substance abuse and lack of pro-social relationships.

The staff make every attempt to engage the family members in services whenever possible. If the staff are unable to engage the family, they will work with the identified child/adolescent on an individual basis. Services can occur from one to three times per week and can be provided in the home, a Wesley Family Services Office, or in a community setting. Our staff schedule services at times that work best for families which can include evenings and weekends. Staff work in collaboration with the youth, family, natural supports, probation officer and other involved service providers.

Services Offered

The In-Home Program provides:

- Individualized Assessment
- Individualized Service Plan Development
- Interventions that target the individualized goals for the child/adolescent and/or family

Interventions are trauma-informed, strengths-based, and solution-focused.

Interventions may include, but are not limited to:

- Education and counseling related to improving relationships, communication, anger management, problem solving, independent living skills, and academic support, etc.
- Support to access community resources such as mental health counseling, drug and alcohol services, special education, and employment assistance.
- Advocacy for and empowering the child and family in interactions with schools, community, and other human service agencies to enhance community connectedness.
