The **Healthy Relationships Curriculum** is a comprehensive, skills-based program designed for adolescents and young adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and/or other social, cognitive, or developmental challenges.

The curriculum focuses on three essential domains that directly support quality of life across adolescence and adulthood:

- Self-Care & Personal Responsibility
- Human Sexuality & Development
- Healthy Relationship Development

These skills are not optional extras. They are foundational life skills that many individuals need explicit, structured instruction to learn and maintain over time.

Why This Curriculum Matters

Over the years, we have witnessed the real pain and long-term consequences that can arise when these skills are not adequately supported: difficulties forming friendships, challenges with employment, social isolation, and avoidable legal involvement.

This curriculum was created to intervene early, teach proactively, and prevent harm to improve safety, promote independence, and nurture emotional well-being for both individuals and their families.
